Emission of nano carbon by CNG vehicles

1370. SHRI KAPIL SIBAL: Will the Minister of ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS be pleased to state:

(a) whether it is a fact that CNG vehicles emit nano carbon particles which can cause cancer, if so, the details thereof;

(b) the steps taken by Government to reduce the emission of nano carbon particles from CNG vehicles; and

(c) if so, whether any research has been conducted to understand which kind of cancer is caused by these particles, if so, the details thereof?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS (SHRI MANSUKH MANDAVIYA): (a) to (c) No, Sir. No such research has been conducted by the Ministry which shows that CNG vehicles emit nano carbon particles which can cause cancer.
