

**Construction of highways**

1372. DR. L. HANUMANTHAIAH: Will the Minister of ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS be pleased to state:

(a) the total length in kilometres, of highways constructed and added to the National Highways network during the last three years;

(b) if so, the details thereof, State-wise and year-wise;

(c) whether Government has taken steps to settle all the dues of the affected people pertaining to land acquisition, resettlement and rehabilitation;

(d) if so, the details thereof;

(e) the total amount of expenditure made for the construction of highways including the compensation for land acquisition etc.; and

(f) if so, the details thereof?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS (SHRI MANSUKH MANDAVIYA): (a) and (b) The State-wise and year-wise details of the National Highways developed based on the requirement of smooth traffic and better connectivity are given in the Statement (*See below*).

(c) and (d) The amount of compensation for the acquisition of land for NHs projects is determined in consonance with the First Schedule to the Right to Fair Compensation and Transparency in Land Acquisition, Rehabilitation and Resettlement Act, 2013, with effect from 01.01.2015. However, under section 3G(5) of the NH Act, 1956, if the amount of compensation so determined, is not acceptable to the land owner, there is a provision for determination of the amount by the arbitrator to be appointed by the Central Government on an application by the party.

(e) and (f) Total amount of expenditure incurred on development of National Highways including the compensation for land acquisition during the last three years is 2,37,668 crore.
