## Discrimination against minorities

- (a) whether Government have received any proposal to frame a concrete programme to address the discrimination being faced by minorities, especially muslims;
  - (b) if so, the action taken thereon; and
- (c) the steps Government have taken for the welfare of muslims during the last three years in the each State?

THE MINISTER OF MINORITY AFFAIRS (SHRI A.R. ANTULAY): (a) and (b) After considering the report of the Sachar Committee, it has been decided to accept in principle its recommendation regarding setting up an Equal Opportunity Commission for looking into the grievances of deprived groups regarding discrimination.

(c) The Prime Minister's New 15 Point Programme for the Welfare of Minorities announced in June, 2006 has been specifically designed for the welfare of minorities. Besides this, a number of schemes exclusively for minorities have been envisaged, namely a merit-cum-means scholarship scheme for technical and professional courses at under-graduate and post-graduate levels and a coaching and allied scheme for students belonging to minority communities.
