THE MINISTER OF STATE OF THE MINISTRY OF MICRO, SMALL AND MEDIUM ENTERPRISES (SHRI GIRIRAJ SINGH): (a) Ministry of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises (MSME) through Khadi and Village Industries Commission (KVIC) does not export directly. The exports of Khadi and Village Industries (KVI) products is done by the KVI units directly or through merchant exporters. Country-wise exports of KVI products during last three years is given in the Statement-I (*See below*).
