Employment in Khadi sector

4261. PROF. M.V. RAJEEV GOWDA: Will the Minister of MICRO, SMALL AND MEDIUM ENTERPRISES be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the introduction of new model charkhas in the production of khadi instead of traditional single spindle charkhas has led to job loss in the sector;
 - (b) if so, the details thereof including estimated number of jobs lost;
- (c) whether Government is taking steps to return to the single spindle charkhas to enhance employment;
 - (d) if so, the details thereof; and
 - (e) if not, the reasons therefor?

THE MINISTER OF STATE OF THE MINISTRY OF MICRO, SMALL AND MEDIUM ENTERPRISES (SHRI GIRIRAJ SINGH): (a) to (c) No, Sir. The new model charkha was introduced long back and side by side the traditional charkha is also in operation. The new model charkha and traditional single spindle charkha are used to produce different counts of fabric. The traditional charkhas are in operation in the Khadi activities especially in woolen spinning and ponduru fine khadi spinning activities and especially in khes, durry etc.
