

Rural Development Scheme

1080. SHRI K. RAHMAN KHAN: Will the Minister of RURAL DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

(a) whether it is a fact that Government has proposed to construct 51 lakh houses for the poor in the coming year;

(b) whether any budgetary allocation has been made to construct these 51 lakh houses; if so, the details thereof; and

(c) the details of the plans for construction of 51 lakh houses so as to achieve the target within one year?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF RURAL DEVELOPMENT (SHRI RAM KRIPAL YADAV): (a) Under Pradhan Mantri Awaas Yojana - Gramin (PMAY-G), one crore Pucca houses are to be completed by March, 2019. Out of these, 51 lakh houses are to be completed by March, 2018.

(b) The total financial implication of the scheme from 1st April, 2016 till 31st March, 2019 is estimated to be ₹81,975 crores. Out of this, ₹60,000 crore has been committed through budgetary resources. The additional financial requirement of ₹21,975 crore shall be met by borrowing from National Bank for Agriculture and Rural Development (NABARD).

(c) The Ministry reviews the progress of house construction against the targets allocated on regular basis through Performance Review Committee (PRC) meetings, PMAY-G Nodal officers meetings, through Area Officers visit, visits of National Level Monitors (NLM) and through Common Review Mission (CRM).
