The objective of the scheme is to enable a large number of minority youths of India to take-up relevant skill sets which are in demand. Under the scheme MAEF will use the cutting-edge of information technology to ensure quality, transparency and credibility to its skill training programmes. All training programmes will be covered by real time CCTV footage for the purpose of monitoring and GPRS enabled bio-metric attendance machines will be used for capturing attendance of trainers and trainees.

(c) MAEF has allocated 6900 skill development training targets in Andhra Pradesh to 11 Project Implementing Agencies (PIAs) for the implementation of above programme.
