Setting up of skill development centres in ITIs

- (a) whether it is a fact that there are around 13,353 Industrial Training Institutes (ITIs) in the country;
- (b) if so, the details thereof, State-wise;
- (c) whether Government had set up Skill Development Centres under Pradhan Mantri Kaushal Vikas Yojana (PMKVY) in all these ITIs;
- (d) if so, the details thereof; and
- (e) if not, the reasons therefor?

THE MINISTER OF SKILL DEVELOPMENT AND ENTREPRENEURSHIP (SHRI DHARMENDRA PRADHAN): (a) Yes Sir, as on 16th May, 2017 there were around 13353 Industrial Training Institutes (ITIs) in the country.

(b) As per the information available on the NCVT MIS Portal. The State-wise number of ITIs has been given in the Statement (*See below*).

(c) to (e) National Skill Development Corporation (NSDC) under the aegis of Ministry of Skill Development and Entrepreneurship (MSDE), have launched SMART-Skill Management and Accreditation of Training Centres, SMART provides a mandatory single window IT application for accreditation and affiliation of prospective Training Centres.

ITIs can also apply for Skill Development Centre, if their demarcated infrastructure meets the PMKVY guidelines and overall ratings as defined in SMART. We do not have any flag in our system for ITIs to highlight them as a PMKVY centre.

Accreditation and affiliation awarded to, a training centre does not make it eligible for targets under any Government scheme including PMKVY.
