Pradhan Mantri Kaushal Vikas Yojana (PMKVY), short-term training is imparted to the youth. Initiative has also been taken to set up Model Skill Centres called Pradhan Mantri Kaushal Kendras (PMKK.s), in districts. Long-term training has been imparted through Industrial Training Institutes (ITIs). The National Apprenticeship Promotion Scheme (NAPS) was launched to promote apprenticeship. Further, convergence has been initiated with 20 Central Ministries/Departments implementing skill development programmes. Under this initiative, 104.16 lakh and 90.78 lakh youth have so far been trained under various programmes of these Ministries/Departments to meet the requirement of various sectors, in 2015-16 and 2016-17 respectively.
