Pending highway projects

2816. DR. AMEE YAJNIK: Will the Minister of ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS be pleased to state:

(a) length in kilometres of roads constructed by the National Highways Authority of India from March, 2009 to May, 2014;

(b) length in kilometres of roads added from May, 2014 till now, details thereof, State-wise;

(c) length in kilometres of roads for which contract have been awarded since May, 2014 till now;

(d) length in kilometres of roads which is still pending for bidding process and the total worth of these bids; and

(e) details of length in kilometres of roads pending for construction despite the bidding process being completed and the total worth of these projects, State-wise?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS (SHRI MANSUKH MANDAVIYA): (a) The total length constructed by National Highways Authority of India from year 2009 up to May, 2014 was approximately 11,710 kms.

(b) The total length of National Highway projects constructed from year 2014 up to November, 2018 is approximately 34,290 kms. The State-wise details are given in Statement (*See below*).

(c) The total length of National Highway projects for which contracts have been awarded since year 2014 up to November, 2018 is approximately 53,180 kms.

(d) Project preparation along with feasibility study/DPR, land acquisition and other pre-construction activities is a continuous process and bidding process for the projects is completed only when the aforesaid activities are concluded. Development/upgradation of projects are taken up from time to time depending upon their *inter-se* priority and availability of funds.

(e) There are approximately 160 nos. of projects having aggregate length of about 6820 kms with approximate total work of ₹ 1,20,000 crores for which the civil works has been awarded but appointed date has not been declared.
