NH projects in Karnataka

2817. SHRI K.C. RAMAMURTHY: Will the Minister of ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS be pleased to state:

(a) whether it is a fact that 18 major National Highway projects are going to be completed before March, 2019, in Karnataka;

(b) if so, details of each of the project, district-wise, that is going to be completed and status of each project, project-wise; and

(c) details of mechanism that the Ministry has to follow to periodically review the major NH projects and meetings/discussions that have been held with State and other officials in connection with monitoring the above projects?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS (SHRI MANSUKH MANDAVIYA): (a) and (b) The details of 9 major National Highway (NH) projects costing more than ₹ 100 crore to be completed by March, 2019 in the State of Karnataka are given in Statement (*See* below).

(c) In order to ensure timely completion of the projects and avoid cost overrun, regular meetings are held with State Government and contractors. To expedite completion of these projects various steps are also taken which include streamlining of land acquisition and environment clearances, premium re-scheduling, close coordination with other Ministries, revamping of dispute resolution mechanism, frequent reviews at various levels etc.
