

Status of National Rural Drinking Water Programme

2740. SHRI MD. NADIMUL HAQUE: Will the Minister of DRINKING WATER AND SANITATION be pleased to state:

(a) whether the National Rural Drinking Water Programme (NRDWP) has missed its targets in providing access to potable piped water and drinking water for the rural population;

(b) if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor, State/UT-wise;

(c) the details of the performance of the programme in providing water connections to households *vis-a-vis* the year-wise targets during the last three years, State/UT-wise; and

(d) the funds allocated, released and utilised by Government for the programme during the said period?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF DRINKING WATER AND SANITATION (SHRI RAMESH CHANDAPPA JIGAJINAGI): (a) and (b) Under centrally sponsored National Rural Drinking Water Programme (NRDWP), this Ministry provides technical and financial assistance to States for improving coverage of safe drinking water in rural areas. Coverage of safe drinking water in rural areas is maintained in terms of Fully Covered habitations (*i.e.* getting more than 40 litre per capita per day (lpcd) safe drinking water), Partially Covered habitations (*i.e.* getting less than 40 lpcd safe drinking water) and Quality Affected habitations (*i.e.* containing chemical contaminant). As reported by States on Integrated Management Information System (IMIS) of the Ministry, status of Fully Covered, Partially Covered and Quality Affected habitations is as under:

It is evident from above table that Fully Covered habitations increased by 6.76%, Partially covered habitations reduced by 5.71% and Quality Affected habitations reduced by 1.05%. It shows significant improvement in the coverage.

State-wise details of coverage of Fully Covered, Partially Covered and Quality Affected habitations are given in Statement-I and details of percentage of population having access to piped water supply are given in Statement-II (*See below*).

(c) Rural drinking water supply being a State subject, it is for the State to plan, design, implement and execute drinking water supply schemes including household connections in rural areas. As reported by States on IMIS, 17.93% of rural households have tap connection as on 03.01.2019. State/UT-wise details of number of household connections for the last three years are given in Statement-III (*See below*). In Piped Water Supply Schemes, taking water connections is at the volition of the household.

(d) The State-wise details of fund allocated, released and utilized (expenditure) for the last three years are given in Statement-IV.
