- (a) whether Government has launched its ambitious healthcare scheme Jan Arogya Abhiyan or Ayushman Bharat Programme recently;
- (b) whether it is a fact that some of the prices of medical services to be given to the people are very much less and are negligible in comparison with the present day rates and medical services providers have expressed their unwillingness to accept such low rates;
- (c) whether any requests from IMA and other private hospitals have been received to review the prices; and
- (d) the steps being taken by Government to take care of the apprehensions of the private hospitals and make modifications accordingly?
