- 14. There are frequent visits by Additional Session Judges to inspect the condition of prisons.
- 15. In association with National Literacy Mission, Ministry of HRD, Government of India, "Padho Aur Padhao" had been launched in Delhi Prisons. This program is vigorously followed in all the jails and as a result, the literacy rate had declined from 40% to around 5%. Further, National Institute of Open Schooling and Indira Gandhi National Open University have opened their sub-centre in Delhi Prison to provide education to the inmates. Also, the computer centre has been established in jails for imparting computer literacy to the prisoners.

## Shifting of CRPF centre to Chandauli, UP

1058. SHRI G C. CHANDRASHEKHAR: Will the Minister of HOME AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether Government is aware of the fact that the CRPF centre in Taralu, Bengaluru is being shifted to Chandauli in Uttar Pradesh, which is causing inconvenience to thousands of employees from South India; and
  - (b) if so, the steps initiated to reverse the decision?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HOME AFFAIRS (SHRI KIREN RIJIJU): (a) to (b) Due to several litigations on Taralu land, the Group Centre could not be established there. Hence, alternative Key Location Plan (KLP) had to be decided.
