

Work on another version of RCS

971. SHRIMATI VIJILA SATHYANANTH: Will the Minister of CIVIL AVIATION be pleased to state:

- (a) whether it is a fact that Government has started work on another version of Regional Air Connectivity Scheme (RCS) for tourist destinations;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) whether it is also a fact that as many as 56 unserved and 17 underserved airports and 31 heliports would be connected under the scheme; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF CIVIL AVIATION (SHRI JAYANT SINHA): (a) and (b) Government has launched Regional Connectivity Scheme (RCS) - UDAN (Ude Desh ka Aam Nagrik) 3.0, which includes Routes requested by Ministry of Tourism. The list is given in the Statement-I (*See* below).

(c) and (d) Details of the Unserved, Underserved Airports and Heliports included in RCS - UDAN are given in the Statement-II, III and IV respectively.

Foreign training of civil aviation officers

972. DR. VIKAS MAHATME: Will the Minister of CIVIL AVIATION be pleased to state:

(a) whether Government is providing foreign training to Civil Aviation Officers through the International Air Transport Association (IATA) and if so, progress made under this during the last three years;

(b) distribution of locations in India at which IATA training centres are located, State/UT-wise;

(c) cost at which IATA provides the training to Civil Aviation officers and funds provided by Government to meet training requirements;

(d) whether there is any mechanism in place to monitor and evaluate training programmes, and if so, the details thereof; and
