Education and employment for poor women

†267. SHRI JAI PARKASH AGGARWAL: Will the Minister of WOMEN AND CHILD DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

(a) whether any programme has been formulated or proposed to be formulated by Government to provide education and opportunities of employment for the welfare of poor, widowed and destitute women;

(b) if so, the details of the centres where these programmes are running, State-wise;

(c) the number of its women beneficiaries during each of the last three years, State-wise; and

(d) the details of the funds allotted during the current Five Year Plan and the State-wise details of the funds utilized till date out of the same?

THE MINISTER OF STATE OF THE MINISTRY OF WOMEN AND CHILD DEVELOPMENT (SHRIMATI RENUKA CHOWDHURY): (a) The scheme of STEP aims to provide employment to poor assetless women in traditional sectors by upgrading skills and other support services.

Swablaban Scheme (which stands transferred to States with effect from 1.4.2006) also provided training and skill development to women to facilitate their employment.

The Scheme of Swayamsidha provides training for income generation activities to women beneficiaries.

(b) and (c) The State-wise details of centres and beneficiaries are available in the Annual Reports of the Ministry and also on the Ministry's *website* www.wcd.nic.in.

(d) The Budget Outlay for the Annual Plan 2007-08 is Rs. 20.00 crore for the STEP Scheme and Rs. 50.90 crore for Swayamsidha Scheme. The fund utilization will be available at the end of the financial year of the Annual Plan 2007-08.
