Use of CFLs

- 238. SHRI B.K. HARIPRASAD: Will the Minister of POWER be pleased to state:
- (a) whether experts estimate that the country could save upto 10,000 MW annually by replacing the common incandescent lamps (bulbs) with the Compact fluorescent Bulbs (CFLs);
- (b) if so, whether any time-frame has been set to phase out the incandescent bulbs from common use; and
- (c) whether at the same time, Government has considered the likely environmental and toxic hazards posed by used CFLs, containing traces of mercury?

THE MINISTER OF POWER (SHRI SUSHILKUMAR SHINDE): (a) Estimates of saving if incandescent bulbs are replaced, vary from 6,500 MW to 10,000 MW.

- (b) No time-frame has been set at present to phase out incandescent bulbs.
- (c) Yes, Sir.

THE MINISTER OF POWER (SHRI SUSHILKUMAR SHINDE): (a) The implementing agencies have reported that electrification works have been carried out in 61542 villages (as on 3rd August 2007) under Rajiv Gandhi Grameen Vidyutikaran Yojana (RGGVY) since it's launch in April 2005. State-wise and year-wise details are given in Statement-1 (See below).

The implementing States so far have availed Rs. 5367.90 crore uptill 3rd August 2007 under RGGVY. Year-wise and State-wise details are given in Statement-II (See below).

(b) Year-wise targets fixed by Govt. vis-a-vis achievements of village electrification under RGGVY are given in Statement-III
