Implementation of National Social Assistance Programme

112. SHRI HUSAIN DALWAI: Will the Minister of RURAL DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

(a) amount of funds disbursed under National Social Assistance Programme, State-wise and year-wise since 2014;

(b) details of method used to determine central assistance to each State under the scheme;

(c) whether Socio-Economic Caste Census is used to estimate number of beneficiaries in each State, if not, reasons therefor;

(d) amount of pension provided per month under various sub-schemes of NSAP in each State;

(e) whether Ministry will revise current rate of pensions under scheme as per inflation levels and if so, details thereof and if not, reasons therefor; and

(f) details of States conducting social audits and submitting reports to Ministry?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF RURAL DEVELOPMENT (SHRI RAM KRIPAL YADAV): (a) to (e) National Social Assistance Programme (NSAP) is a welfare programme for the persons belonging to below poverty line (BPL) households, which covers 3.09 crore beneficiaries. Under the above schemes the targeted beneficiaries are provided with monthly central assistance ranging between

₹ 200-500 depending on age of the beneficiary and category of the pension. The details of amount of funds disbursed under National Social Assistance Programme, State-wise and year-wise since 2014 is given in the Statement (*See below*).

No decision has been taken for identification of beneficiaries on the basis of Socio Economic Caste Census (SECC) 2011. Further, under the current framework of the scheme upward revision of pension for discounting the inflation rates has not been provided.

(f) As per the information received from 12 States/UTs namely Assam, Dadra and Nagar Haveli, Jharkhand, Karnataka, Madhya Pradesh, Manipur, Meghalaya, Mizoram, Odisha, Tamil Nadu, Tripura and Uttarakhand have periodic social audits, 3 States/UTs namely Chhattisgarh, Telangana and West Bengal have social audits once in a year. To bring about uniformity in the social audit, guidelines have been issued recently by Ministry of Rural Development.

(a) action taken by Government to provide additional working days under Mahatma Gandhi National Rural Employment Guarantee Scheme (MGNREGS) in various States in the country; and

(b) if so, details of total working days allotted additionally, State-wise and the quantum of funds allocated, sanctioned and released during the last three years to various States?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF RURAL DEVELOPMENT (SHRI RAM KRIPAL YADAV): (a) and (b) An additional 50 days of wage employment are provided over and above 100 days in the notified drought affected areas or natural calamity areas in the country on recommendation of the Ministry of Agriculture and Farmers Welfare. Additional 50 days of wage employment provided in notified areas of Andhra Pradesh, Karnataka, Gujarat, Maharashtra, Kerala and Tamil Nadu in the FY 2018-19 (as on 31.01.2019). Mahatma Gandhi National Rural Employment Guarantee Act, 2005 (MGNREGA) is a demand driven wage employment Scheme, hence no State/UT- wise allocation of fund is made. The details of persondays generated (including additional 50 days) and Central fund released under Mahatma Gandhi National Rural Employment Guarantee Scheme (MGNREGS) during the last three years *i.e.* 2015-16, 2016-17 and 2017-18 are given in the Statement.
