# Framing of New Tourism Policy

- (a) whether any step has been taken to frame New Tourism Policy;
- (b) if so, the steps taken to attract tourists of those countries where Buddhism has spread; and
- (c) the steps taken to attract more tourists to tourist places like Bodh Gaya, Sarnath, Kushinagar and to provide more facilities to the tourists?

THE MINISTER OF STATE OF THE MINISTRY OF TOURISM (SHRI K. J. ALPHONS): (a) The Ministry of Tourism has formulated a draft New Tourism Policy, which is currently being reviewed.

(b) and (c) The Ministry of Tourism with a view to showcase India's Buddhist Heritage and boost tourism to the Buddhist sites in the country organises the International Buddhist Conclave, wherein Scholars, senior leaders of various Buddhist sects, opinion makers, journalists, international tour operators selling packages tours

to Buddhist sites are invited from various countries including those where Buddhism has spread. A short promotional film 'India - The Land of Buddha' has been produced and aired in overseas markets to promote Buddhist Sites of the country. These sites are also promoted through the Incredible India Website, social media handles of the Ministry of Tourism and through other promotional activities including roadshows, participation in travel fairs and exhibition and India seminars, etc.

The Ministry of Tourism under its schemes of Swadesh Darshan, PRASHAD and Assistance to Central Agencies for Tourism Infrastructure Development has sanctioned projects for development of infrastructure and providing facilities at Buddhist Sites in the country. Details of the same are given in the Statement.

# 2. PRASHAD Scheme

Buddhism works have been undertaken in the following two projects under PRASHAD Scheme:-
