**Exclusion of eligible beneficiaries from Ayushman Bharat Yojana**

229. SHRI VIJAY PAL SINGH TOMAR: Will the Minister of HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE be pleased to state:

(a) the number of people benefited through the Ayushman Bharat Yojana since its implementation till date in various parts of the country including Uttar Pradesh; and

(b) whether it is a fact that some of eligible beneficiaries have been excluded from the said Yojana. if so. the action taken to include all the eligible persons under this Yojana?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE (SHRI ASHWINI KUMAR CHOUBEY): (a) The total number of hospital admissions in the States/UTs implementing the Pradhan Mantri Jan Arogya Yojana (PMJAY) since launch of the scheme till 30.01.2019 are 9,97,901. In Uttar Pradesh, hospital admissions under the scheme are 27,146.

(b) PMJAY is an entitlement based scheme and families figuring in identified criteria for rural areas and 11 occupational categories for urban areas as per the Socio Economic Cast; Census (SECC) data base are entitled to avail benefits under PMJAY and no eligible beneficiaries have been excluded from PMJAY.

#### **AIIMS in the country**

†230. MS. SAROJ PANDEY: Will the Minister of HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE be pleased to state the number of AIIMS established in the country before 2014 and the number of AIIMS established in the tenure of the present Government and the details of the places where they have been established?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE (SHRI ASHWINI KUMAR CHOUBEY): Six new AIIMS in Patna (Bihar), Raipur (Chhattisgarh), Bhopal (Madhya Pradesh), Bhubaneswar (Orissa), Jodhpur (Rajasthan) and Rishikesh (Uttaranchal) have been established in the country before 2014. An AIIMS in Rae Bareilly was approved to be set up in 2009.

During the tenure of the present Government, 14 new AIIMS have been announced to be set up in various States of the country and are in various stages of construction. Details are given in the Statement.
