

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE (SHRI ASHWINI KUMAR CHOUBEY): (a) The total number of hospital admissions in the States/UTs implementing the Pradhan Mantri Jan Arogya Yojana (PMJAY) since launch of the scheme till 30.01.2019 are 9,97,901. In Uttar Pradesh, hospital admissions under the scheme are 27,146.

(b) PMJAY is an entitlement based scheme and families figuring in identified criteria for rural areas and 11 occupational categories for urban areas as per the Socio Economic Cast; Census (SECC) data base are entitled to avail benefits under PMJAY and no eligibh beneficiaries have been excluded from PMJAY.

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE (SHRI ASHWINI KUMAR CHOUBEY): Six new AIIMS in Patna (Bihar), Raipur (Chhattisgarh), Bhopal (Madhya Pradesh), Bhubaneswar (Orissa), Jodhpur (Rajasthan) and Rishikesh (Uttaranchal) have been established in the country before 2014. An AIIMS in Rae Bareli was approved to be set up in 2009.

During the tenure of the present Government, 14 new AIIMS have been announced to be set up in various States of the country and are in various stages of construction. Details are given in the Statement.
