

Help to establish new industries in Gujarat

‡398. SHRI NARANBHAI J. RATHWA: Will the Minister of MICRO, SMALL AND MEDIUM ENTERPRISES be pleased to state:

(a) the details of the financial and non-financial help given to industrial establishments during the last three years by the Ministry to establish new industries in the districts of Gujarat;

(b) the number of such industrial establishments of districts of Gujarat which have taken advantage of this during last two years; and

(c) the details of the production of the above mentioned industrial establishments during last two years?

THE MINISTER OF STATE OF THE MINISTRY OF MICRO, SMALL AND MEDIUM ENTERPRISES (SHRI GIRIRAJ SINGH): (a) to (c) Central Government implements various schemes and programmes for the promotion and development of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises (MSMEs) throughout the country including Gujarat. These include the schemes/programmes such as Prime Minister's Employment Generation Programme (PMEGP), Scheme of Fund for Regeneration of Traditional Industries (SFURTI), A Scheme for Promoting Innovation, Rural Industry and Entrepreneurship (ASPIRE), Credit Guarantee Fund Scheme for Micro, and Small Enterprises, Credit Linked Capital Subsidy Scheme (CLCSS), National Manufacturing Competitiveness Programme (NMCP), Micro & Small Enterprises - Cluster Development Programme (MSE-CDP), National Scheduled Caste and Scheduled Tribe Hub (NSSH), and schemes for coir products and Khadi and Village Industries.

National Small Industries Corporation (NSIC) under the Ministry of MSME also promotes and supports MSMEs by providing integrated support services encompassing marketing, finance, technology and other services.

Details of financial and non-financial help given to industrial establishments through the major schemes of the Ministry of MSME, in the State of Gujarat during the last three years are as given below:—
