

Under Pradhan Mantri Kaushal Vikas Yojana (PMKVY), a flagship scheme of Ministry of Skill Development and Entrepreneurship, no provision of training in camps. However, under the Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL) component of PMKVY, there is a provision of orientation in camp mode. RPL in Camp mode is suitable where a certain group/cluster of candidates with particular skill set are concentrated. Under this, 11417 and 6226 female have been enrolled and certified respectively in Maharashtra.

THE MINISTER OF SKILL DEVELOPMENT AND ENTREPRENEURSHIP (SHRI DHARMENDRA PRADHAN): (a) to (c) Pradhan Mantri Kaushal Vikas Yojana (2016-20) is the flagship outcome-based skill training scheme of the Ministry of Skill Development and Entrepreneurship (MSDE). The objective of the scheme is to encourage and promote skill development for the youth throughout the country including Karnataka. The scheme aims to benefit 10 million youth over the period of four years (2016- 20). As on 24th January, 2019, more than 35 lakh candidates have been trained pan India. District-wise details of the candidates trained and placed under various components of PMKVY (2016-20) in the State of Karnataka are given in Statement-I to III.
