MGNREGA funds for Madhya Pradesh

(b) the number of beneficiaries under MGNREGA in the State, district-wise; and

(c) the funds likely to be advanced to the State Government during the next three years?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF RURAL DEVELOPMENT (SHRI RAM KRIPAL YADAV): (a) The Mahatma Gandhi National Rural Employment Guarantee Act (MGNREGA), 2005 is a demand driven wage employment Scheme, hence no State/UT-wise allocation of fund is made. The details of Central fund released to Madhya Pradesh under the MGNREGA during the last three financial years are given below:—
