THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF RURAL DEVELOPMENT (SHRI RAM KRIPAL YADAV): (a) to (d) The Ministry releases funds to the States/ UTs based on the basis of the agreed to Labour Budget, opening balance, pending liabilities of the previous financial year, if any, and overall performance. Fund release to States/UTs is a continuous process and Central Government is committed in making funds available keeping in view the demand for work. The Ministry seeks additional fund as and when required for meeting the demand for work on the ground. During the current financial year 2018-19 (as on 08.02.2019) under Mahatma Gandhi National Rural Employment Guarantee Scheme (MGNREGS), Budget allocation has been increased from ₹ 55,000 crore to ₹ 61,084 crore.

## MoU of Ministry with Maruti Suzuki

876. SHRI SUSHIL KUMAR GUPTA: Will the Minister of RURAL DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Ministry has signed an MoU with Maruti Suzuki India Ltd. for training rural youth for skill development under the Deen Dayal Upadhyay Kaushal Yojana;
  - (b) if so, the details in this regard;
- (c) the names of organisations with which the Ministry has signed MoUs for training rural youth; and
  - (d) the number of people trained during the last three years by these organisations?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF RURAL DEVELOPMENT (SHRI RAM KRIPAL YADAV): (a) and (b) Yes, Ministry of Rural Development signed an MoU on 19th December, 2018 with Maruti Suzuki India Ltd. (Champion Employer Organisation) for training rural youth for skill development. The MoU mainly includes:

- (i) The MoU between the 'Principal' and Champion Employer Organisation confirms that the Champion Employer Organisation is committed to train atleast 5000 candidates in 2 years and place atleast 40% in 'Captive Employment' or Affiliate Companies, in terms of DDUGKY Guidelines.
- (ii) Champion Employer commits to undertake skill training courses with a minimum duration of 6 months.
- (iii) Champion Employer confirms that the starting pay (Cost to Company)

for all placements, under the 'Champion Employer' program, shall be at least ₹ 8000 per month.

- (iv) Champion Employer commits to ensure that at least 50% of total placed candidates by it shall be able to draw a CTC of ₹ 10,000/- per month at the end of one year of placement and CTC of ₹ 15,000/- per month at the end of four years.
- (v) the Champion Employer commits to assure availability of a clearly defined career progression pathway (upto the supervisory level) in 4 years to a candidate skilled under its DDUGKY project.
- (c) and (d) Ministry has signed MoU with 13 Champion Employers and 4 government agencies empaneled for undertaking DDU-GKY projects. The number of candidates trained by these organisations during last three years and current year (2018-19) till 8.2.19 is given below:—
