#### Repair and rehabilitation work of various dams

907. SHRI C. M. RAMESH: Will the Minister of WATER RESOURCES, RIVER DEVELOPMENT AND GANGA REJUVENATION be pleased to state:

(a) whether Government has made any survey for repair and rehabilitation work of various dams across the country, if so, details of the amount earmarked for it during the last three years for the purpose; and

(b) the details of number of repair and rehabilitation work on various dams which have been completed and those which still remain completion?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF WATER RESOURCES, RIVER DEVELOPMENT AND GANGA REJUVENATION (SHRI ARJUN RAM MEGHWAL): (a) and (b) Safety of dams including dam operation, rehabilitation and maintenance rests primarily with dam owners which are generally State Governments, Central and State power generating PSUs, Municipalities and private companies etc. In order to supplement the efforts of the State Governments, Ministry of Water Resources, River Development and Ganga Rejuvenation (MoWR, RD and GR) provides technical and financial assistance through various schemes and programmes such as Dam Rehabilitation and Improvement Programme (DRIP).

DRIP, a World Bank funded project was started in April, 2012 and scheduled to be completed in June, 2020 for the rehabilitation of about 198 dam projects from the point of view of safety across the seven States of India, namely Kerala, Madhya Pradesh, Odisha, Tamil Nadu, Karnataka, Jharkhand (Damodar Valley Corporation) and Uttarakhand (Uttarakhand Jal Vidyut Nigam Ltd.). Original budget outlay of the project was ₹ 2100 crores DRIP originally was a six year scheme with a scheduled closing date of 30th June, 2018. Government of India in September, 2018 approved the Revised Cost of DRIP for ₹ 3466 crores along with two years extension.

Each dam has certain number of work packages for rehabilitation of dams under DRIP *viz* Civil, Hydro-mechanical, Electrical, goods and services etc. As on date total number of work packages is 1072 for 198 dam projects. Out of these 586 work packages have been completed, 377 work packages are at different stages of execution and 109 work packages are at tendering stage.

### Pending projects of Karnataka

908. SHRI G.C. CHANDRASHEKHAR: Will the Minister of WATER RESOURCES, RIVER DEVELOPMENT AND GANGA REJUVENATION be pleased to state:

(a) whether Government has received several requests from various States/

UTs especially Karnataka Government for grant of approval to the projects/schemes pertaining to various sectors *viz*. water resources, irrigation, desiltation, river cleaning, water conservation and management, dams capacity utilization etc. during the last three years;

(b) if so, the details thereof indicating name of projects/schemes sanctioned and pending for clearance;

(c) the details of ongoing projects/schemes and those pending for implementation/ completion pertaining to each of the said sectors; and

(d) whether some of the said projects/schemes have incurred time and cost overruns and if so, details thereof and corrective action taken thereon?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF WATER RESOURCES, RIVER DEVELOPMENT AND GANGA REJUVENATION (SHRI ARJUN RAM MEGHWAL): (a) and (b) During the last three years, 129 project proposals have been received in CWC in respect of Major/Medium Irrigation (MMI) and Multipurpose projects from State Governments. Out of these proposals, 76 proposals have been considered and accepted by Advisory Committee of MoWR, RD and GR. Another 38 proposals are currently under appraisal, and 15 proposals have been sent back to the Project Authorities. State-wise details of the proposals, including proposals of Karnataka, are given in the Statement (*See* below).

(c) and (d) In order to supplement efforts of State Governments with their ongoing projects, Government of India provides technical and financial assistance through various schemes and programs. During 2016-17, 99 ongoing Major/Medium irrigation projects (including 5 in Karnataka) were prioritized for mission mode completion by December, 2019 under Pradhan Mantra Krishi Sinchayee Yojana (PMKSY)-Accelerated Irrigation Benefits Programme (AIBP) along with their Command Area Development and Water Management (CADWM) works. These projects targeted an ultimate irrigation potential of 76.03 lakh hectares at balance estimated cost of ₹ 77,595 crores (with Central Assistance of ₹ 31342.50 crores). AIBP works of 31 projects (including 2 in Karnataka) have been completed/almost completed.

Out of 99 prioritized projects, 86 projects (5 in Karnataka) have been included for CADWM intervention. As per included projects, it is targeted to develop 42.69 lakh hectare of Culturable Command Area (CCA), including 0.84 lakh hectares of CCA in Karnataka. Total estimated cost of CADWM works is ₹ 17799.565 crore (₹ 1020.04 crore in Karnataka) with total Central share ₹ 8176.303 crore (₹ 188.13 crore for Karnataka). Command area works have been completed in CCA of 12.26 lakh hectare (including 0.27 lakh hectare in Karnataka).

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In addition to 99 prioritized projects, Central assistance to State Governments is also being given under schemes of River Management in Border Area (RMBA), Flood Management Program (FMP), Surface Minor Irrigation (SMI), and Repair, Renovation and Restoration (RRR) of water bodies. During last three years (from 2016-17), Central assistance given under these schemes are ₹ 159.25 crores (RMBA), ₹ 1178.68 crores (FMP, including merged component of RMBA in 2018-19), ₹ 1341.27 crores (SMI) and ₹ 101.74 crores (RRR).

Time and cost overrun in irrigation projects happens due to several reasons such as land acquisition, Resettlements and Rehabilitation, delay in statutory clearances, geological surprises during execution, litigations etc. Measures have been taken under 99 prioritized projects for time bound completion and to address cost escalation in below listed manner:-

- 20% cost escalation on latest approved estimated cost (AIBP component) of project as on March 2012 may be allowed for which, no separate clearance/ TAC clearance/Investment Clearance will be required for funding these projects.
- Fast Track Pro-forma Clearance from CWC may be sufficient for projects where revised cost may be more than the 20% over and above approved cost as on 01.04.2012 and no separate investment clearance from MOWR may be required.
- Entire cost escalation above 20% to be borne by the concerned State Government. The MoWR, RD and GR would facilitate this by arranging loan from NABARD.
- Extensive review of ongoing project is done at various levels including NITI Aayog to expedite the progress and address various bottlenecks.
