Financial assistance to Andhra Pradesh for drought relief

*71. SHRI PRABHAKAR REDDY VEMIREDDY: Will the Minister of AGRICULTURE AND FARMERS WELFARE be pleased to state:

(a) whether it is a fact that in spite of healthy rains this year, nearly 300

mandals in six districts, including Nellore, in Andhra Pradesh, suffered drought-like conditions;

(b) if so, the details of mandals declared as drought-affected in Andhra Pradesh, district-wise and informed to the Ministry;

(c) whether the State Government has submitted any proposal for financial assistance under National Disaster Relief Fund; and

(d) if so, the reasons for delay in sending Central Team and by when Ministry would provide financial assistance to Andhra Pradesh?

THE MINISTER OF AGRICULTURE AND FARMERS WELFARE (SHRI RADHA MOHAN SINGH): (a) and (b) The State Government of Andhra Pradesh declared drought in 09 districts, including Nellore, covering 347 mandals during Kharif 2018. Names of mandals declared as drought-affected, district-wise, are given in Statement (*See below*).

(c) The State Government of Andhra Pradesh submitted Memorandum for Drought Kharif 2018 seeking financial assistance of ₹ 1466.91 crore from National Disaster Response Fund (NDRF).

(d) An Inter-Ministerial Central Team (IMCT) visited the drought affected areas of the State during 5th to 7th December, 2018. Based on the findings of the IMCT and the recommendations of the Sub-Committee of National Executive Committee (SC-NEC), the High Level Committee (HLC) in its meeting held on 29.01.2019, has already approved ₹ 900.40 crore from NDRF to Andhra Pradesh for drought Kharif 2018. Hence, there has been no delay.
