

Expansion of Gutti-Tadipatri Highway

841. SHRI T. G. VENKATESH: Will the Minister of ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS be pleased to state:

(a) whether the Ministry has given its acceptance to the expansion of Gutti-Tadipatri Highway into a four lane road and if so, the details thereof;

(b) the details of quantum of funds being allocated for this expansion work; and

(c) whether any time-frame has been fixed to complete the work, if so, the details thereof?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS (SHRI MANSUKH MANDAVIYA): (a) Ministry has sanctioned rehabilitation and upgradation of Gooty-Tadipatri section of NH-67 from km 424/650 to km 487/693 to two lane with paved shoulders in the State of Andhra Pradesh. Out of the total project length of 63.043 km, a length of 3.72 km is to be upgraded to Four/Six lane in built-up areas.

(b) and (c) The sanctioned cost of the above project is ₹ 378.24 crore. The above work has commenced on 19.01.2018 and scheduled date of completion is 18.01.2020.
