Mission Kakatiya in Telangana

SHRI V. LAKSHMIKANTHA RAO (Telangana): Thank you, Sir, for having given me this opportunity to speak because after a long wait, I got a chance today.

It is known that the 29th State of India, Telangana, was formed in 2014. And, before that the irrigation tanks were filled up with silt and the storage of water was not sufficient there as it was estimated to be.

So, the Government of Telangana has immediately taken up the work of restoring the tanks and also constructing the check dams. There are about 46,531 minor irrigation tanks and, now, the Government wants to construct 4,398 check dams also in the Telangana State. The ayacut which was to be irrigated was about 20 lakh acres, which has come down to 9-10 lakhs. This has all happened because of the negligence of Minor Irrigation Department. These tanks have been handed over to Panchayati Raj Department and the Panchayati Raj Department never cares to repair them. Now it has become essential for the Telangana Government to take up construction of these tanks.

The work has been started and this is named as Mission Kakatiya. Mission Kakatiya work is going on in a phased manner. Every year, 20 per cent of these tanks are being restored. That plan is in progress and four phases have already been completed. The main aim of the Kakatiya Mission is to increase the coverage of reliable minor irrigation facilities through surface and groundwater management. Growth in agricultural...
