THE MINISTER OF STATE OF THE MINISTRY OF YOUTH AFFAIRS AND SPORTS (SHRI KIREN RIJIJU): (a) Pension of sportspersons has been doubled with effect from 1.4.2018 under the Scheme of ÂSports fund for Pension to Meritorious SportspersonsÊ. After doubling the pension amount is as below:
