Pradhan Mantri Swasthya Suraksha Yojana

1856. SHRI DHIRAJ PRASAD SAHU: Will the Minister of HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE be pleased to state:

(a) whether any action has been taken by Government to upgrade medical colleges in Jharkhand under Pradhan Mantri Swasthya Suraksha Yojana (PMSSY), if so, the details thereof; and

(b) the corrective measures taken to upgrade the Government Medical Colleges in the country?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE (SHRI ASHWINI KUMAR CHOUBEY): (a) Yes. The following Government Medical Colleges in Jharkhand have been taken up for upgradation under Pradhan Mantri Swasthya Suraksha Yojana (PMSSY):

1. Rajendra Institute of Medical Sciences (RIMS), Ranchi (Phase-I).
2. Patliputra Medical College, Dhanbad (Phase-III).

The details of the upgradation work at these medical colleges are given in Statement-I (*See below*).

(b) The Government has undertaken upgradation of existing Government Medical Colleges/Institutions at various parts of the country, under PMSSY, as detailed in Statement-II (*See below*). The upgradation programme involves construction of Super Speciality Blocks/Trauma Centres and procurement of medical equipment.

Further, with the objective of creating more MBBS seats in Government Colleges in the country, the Government has introduced Centrally Sponsored Scheme for

Upgradation of existing State Government/Central Government medical colleges to increase MBBS seats. 36 Medical Colleges, as per the list in Statement-III, have been approved under the scheme to increase 2615 UG seats.

The Government has also introduced a Centrally Sponsored Scheme for Strengthening and upgradation of State Government Medical colleges for starting new PG disciplines and increasing PG seats. A total of 72 Government Medical Colleges in 21 States/UTs have been approved under Phase-I of the Scheme for increasing 4058 PG seats. List of the approved medical colleges under Phase-I of the Scheme is given in Statement-IV (*See* below). Under Phase-II of the Scheme, 5 Government Medical Colleges, as detailed in Statement-V, have been approved for increasing 98 PG seats.

Changes in Preventive Healthcare Services

†1857. SHRI LAL SINH VADODIA: Will the Minister of HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE be pleased to state:

(a) whether it is a fact that Government is not contemplating to bring in holistic changes in public and preventive healthcare services;

(b) if so, whether Government has taken any step in this direction; and

(c) if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE (SHRI ASHWINI KUMAR CHOUBEY): (a) to (c) Public Health and Hospitals being a State subject, the primary responsibility of provision of healthcare including preventive healthcare is that of respective State Government. However, under National Health Mission, support is being provided to States/UTs for strengthening of their healthcare system including primary care, based on their proposals.

This support under NHM includes provision of a host of free services such as maternal health, child health, adolescent health, family planning, universal immunisation programme, and for major diseases such as Tuberculosis, HIV/AIDS, vector borne diseases like Malaria, Dengue and Kala Azar, Leprosy etc.
