

Status of NESRIP

3296. SHRI KAMAKHYA PRASAD TASA : Will the Minister of ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS be pleased to state:

(a) the status of project titled 'ADB' assisted North Eastern State Roads Investment Programme' (NESRIP) for construction of four lane bridge including approaches over river Brahmaputra between Dhubri on North Bank in Assam and Phulbari on South Bank on NH-127B in Meghalaya; and

(b) the revised cost of project and projected date of completion along with the name of executing agency?

THE MINISTER OF ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS (SHRI NITIN JAIRAM GADKARI) : (a) and (b) The work of construction of Four-lane bridge including approaches over River Brahmaputra between Dhubri on North Bank in Assam and Phulbari on South Bank on NH-127 B in Meghalaya does not come under the project titled 'ADB' assisted North Eastern State Roads Investment Programme (NESRIP) but is being taken up with loan assistance from Japan International Cooperation Agency (JICA). This work falls under the project 'North East Road Network Connectivity Improvement Project'.

The estimated cost of this work is ₹ 4997.04 crore. The construction period is 7 years and 9 months and the projected date of completion is in the year 2026-27. National Highways and Infrastructure Development Corporation Limited (NHIDCL), a Central Public Sector Enterprise (CPSE) under this Ministry, is the executing agency.

Status of Palariuattom flyover on NH
