Survey on cities

2640. SHRI PRABHAKAR REDDY VEMIREDDY: Will the Minister of HOUSING AND URBAN AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

(a) whether it is a fact that Government has conducted a survey to rank 4,000 cities and towns in the country;

(b) if so, the details of parameters adopted for such survey and when the results of survey are going to be announced; and

(c) amount spent under Swachh Bharat Mission-Urban (SBM-U) in the country, with a particular reference to Andhra Pradesh and Telangana?

THE MINISTER OF STATE OF THE MINISTRY OF HOUSING AND URBAN AFFAIRS (SHRI HARDEEP SINGH PURI): (a) Government of India have been conducting annual survey namely, Swachh Survekshan under Swachh Bharat Mission-Urban (SBM-U) since 2016 to rank cities/towns on the basis of cleanliness parameters. Year-wise details of Urban Local Bodies (ULBs) covered under Swachh Survekshan are as under:—

(b) Under Swachh Survekshan, ULBs are assessed against four parameters/components namely (i) Service Level Progress, (ii) Certification for Garbage Free City Rating and Open Defecation Free (ODF) status, (iii) Direct Observation, and (iv) Citizen's feedback. Swachh Survekshan Survey 2019 was conducted in the month of January 2019 and results were declared in March, 2019.

(c) As on 30.11.2019, a sum of ₹10192.68 crores, including ₹517.43 crores for Andhra Pradesh and ₹196.25 crores for Telangana have been released under SBM-U.
