Violations of emergency row seat guidelines by various airlines

2573. SHRI VIVEK K. TANKHA: Will the Minister of CIVIL AVIATION be pleased to state the details of the violations by various airlines regarding the guidelines/rules as promulgated by the Ministry/DGCA regarding pre-assigning of emergency row seats to ensure appropriateness of persons occupying those seats and the action taken/penalty imposed in such cases during the last three years?

THE MINISTER OF STATE OF THE MINISTRY OF CIVIL AVIATION (SHRI HARDEEP SINGH PURI): The Directorate General of Civil Aviation (DGCA) has laid down guidelines/rules on pre-assigning emergency row seat, to ensure appropriateness of persons occupying emergency row seat *vide* Civil Aviation Requirement (CAR) Section 8 Series O Part VIII. No violation of these guidelines has come to the notice of the DGCA during inspections carried out by their officials in last three years.
