- (c) whether any specific area has been identified as their habitation where they were usually found;
- (d) whether any proposal has been received from Madhya Pradesh Government for closing down of the Son Gharial Wildlife Sanctuary; and
 - (e) if so, the details of action taken thereon and if not, the reasons therefor?

THE MINISTER OF ENVIRONMENT, FOREST AND CLIMATE CHANGE (SHRI PRAKASH JAVADEKAR): (a) As per the Government of Madhya Pradesh Gazette Notification dated 23rd September, 1981, the Son Gharial Wildlife Sanctuary has its jurisdiction along the rivers Son, Gopad and Banas upto a width of 200 meter wide strip along both sides of river banks. It has an area of 223.95 sqkm. and the length of the Son Gharial Wildlife Sanctuary is 209.21 km.

- (b) As informed by the State Government of Madhya Pradesh, the total number of Gharial in the Son Gharial Wildlife Sanctuary is 45 as per the survey conducted in the month of February, 2019.
- (c) State Government of Madhya Pradesh has informed that as per the survey report, there are 6 Pools identified where crocodiles are commonly found in the Son Gharial Wildlife Sanctuary.
- (d) No, Sir. No proposal has been received from State Government of Madhya Pradesh for closing down of the Son Gharial Wildlife Sanctuary.
 - (e) In view of (d) above, the question does not arise.

- (b) There are 123 coal mining projects under implementation and the names of these projects are at Statement A. Out of these projects, 51 projects are delayed.
- Time line fixed for making 51 delayed projects operational is given in the Statement (B).
- (d) Out of 51 delayed Projects, 10 nos. of Projects are delayed due to issues related to EC and FC. The list of such projects is given in the Statement (C).
