THE MINISTER OF MICRO, SMALL AND MEDIUM ENTERPRISES (SHRI NITIN JAIRAM GADKARI): (a) to (c) Details of Technology Business Incubators (TBIs) and Livelihood Business Incubators (LBIs) approved, set up, functional and investment made under 'A Scheme for Promotion of Innovation, Rural Industry and Entrepreneurship' (ASPIRE) during the last three years, year-wise and State-wise is given in Statement-I (*See below*)

(b) Details of number of youth trained and killed through various LBIs established under ASPIRE is given in Statement-II (*See below*). TBI is a type of incubator providing opportunity to the innovators in developing and nurturing their new innovative ideas for the production of new innovative products which can be sent in to the market for commercialization. No training is provided under TBI.

(d) Fund of Funds with a corpus of ₹ 310 crore was established under ASPIRE programme with SIDBI as Fund Manager. Under the Fund of Funds programme, commitments are being made to individual Alternative Investment Funds (AIFs) registered with Securities and Exchange Board of India (SEBI). These AIFs will invest in MSMEs that are Agro/Rural focused.
