Self-Employment under PMRY

105. DR. AMEE YAJNIK: Will the Minister of MICRO, SMALL AND MEDIUM ENTERPRISES be pleased to state:

- (a) the number of youths provided self-employment under the Prime Minister Rojgar Yojana (PMRY) during the last two years, State-wise;
 - (b) the rules fixed under the Yojana in this regard;
- (c) whether the recommendation of the State Government is necessary for self- employment under the scheme; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof and the number of youths who have been recommended for self-employment by the State Governments during the above period, State-wise?

THE MINISTER OF MICRO, SMALL AND MEDIUM ENTERPRISES (SHRI NITIN JAIRAM GADKARI): (a) Pradhan Mantri Rojgar Yojna (PMRY) has been discontinued w.e.f 01-04-2008. PMRY and Rural Employment Generation Programme (REGP) were merged to form Prime Minister's Employment Generation Programme (PMEGP).

Ministry of MSME is implementing Prime Minister's Employment Generation Programme (PMEGP), which is a major credit-linked subsidy programme aimed at generating self-employment opportunities through establishment of micro-enterprises in the non-farm sector by helping traditional artisans and unemployed youth.

The number of estimated employment opportunities created under PMEGP from Financial Year 2017-18 is given below:

(b) The scheme is being implemented by Khadi and Village Industries Commission (KVIC), State Khadi and Village Industries Board (KVIB) and District

Industries centres (DIC). Under the scheme, loan is being provided by all Public Sector Banks and selected private sector banks and co-operative banks and the margin money subsidy is provided by Ministry of MSME through KVIC.

Any individual above 18 years of age is eligible. General category beneficiaries can avail margin money subsidy of 25 % of the project cost in rural areas and 15% in urban areas. Beneficiaries belonging to special categories such as scheduled caste/ scheduled tribe/OBC /minorities/women, ex-serviceman, physically handicapped, NER, Hill and Border areas etc. can avail the margin money subsidy of 35% in rural areas and 25% in urban areas. The maximum cost of projects can be ₹ 25 lakh in the manufacturing sector and ₹ 10 lakh in the service sector. Benefit can be availed under PMEGP for setting up of new units only. All Agro Based Food Processing Industries and other Khadi and Village Industries except for the industries under the negative list (such as Tobacco, Meat, intoxicants, Polythene bags less than 20 microns etc.) are covered under PMEGP scheme.

Further, Ministry of MSME has also introduced a new component of second financial assistance for expansion/upgrading the existing PMEGP/MUDRA units (for manufacturing unit upto 1.00 cr. and for service/ trading unit upto ₹25.00 lakhs with subsidy of 15% for non NER and 20% for NER and hilly state) from the year 2018-19
