- (1) S.O. 5621 (E), dated the 2nd November, 2018, issuing instructions that all Companies registered under the Companies Act, 2013 with turnover of more than Rs. 500 crores and all Central Public Sector Enterprises shall be required to get themselves onboarded on the Trade Receivables Discounting System platform and other related matters.
- (2) S.O. 5622 (E), dated the 2nd November, 2018, directing that all Companies who get supplies of goods or services from micro and small enterprises and whose payments to micro and small enterprise suppliers exceed forty five days from the date of acceptance or the date of deemed acceptance of the goods or services as per the provisions of the Act, shall submit a half yearly return to the Ministry of Corporate Affairs as per conditions mentioned therein.
