Need to route all major trains via Cuttack in Odisha

SHRI SUBHASH CHANDRA SINGH (Odisha): * "I would like to speak about some issues of Odisha which are not about any particular district; these are rather concerned with the entire State. Cuttack was the old capital of Odisha. It is the transit point and economic hub of the State. The High Court of Odisha, Judicial Academy, and National Law University - all are located here. Cuttack will soon become the medical hub of the State as well since AIIMS Plus institution is coming up there. More than 20 to 30 thousand patients from the neighbouring States like West Bengal,

Jharkhand, Bihar, Chhattisgarh and Western Odisha come to SCB Medical College of Odisha every day for their treatment. Cuttack is not just district. Cuttack is a hub of Odisha, a judicial hub, an educational centre of the State and a commercial centre. Cuttack is also an educational hub where Ravenshaw University, National Law University and National Urdu University are located. Most of the plumbers working in different parts of the country belong to the undivided Cuttack comprising four present-day districts of Kendrapara, Jajpur, Jagatsinghpur and Cuttack. These plumbers go to the nook and corner of the country. They are providing their services even in Delhi, including in Parliament and in other places.

Many trains ply via Cuttack but some of the important trains do not go to Cuttack. Even the indirect trains like those connecting Western part of Odisha that are going from Bhubaneswar to Rourkela, Bhubaneswar to Balangir, Bhubaneswar to Sambalpur including some of the major trains, are not routed via Cuttack. There are four major trains that go to Gujarat but none of them goes via Cuttack. As a result of that, most of the plumbers and labourers have to go to Bhubaneswar to catch their trains. They are forced to remain awake whole night and are stranded at Bhubaneswar facing lots of hardship.

A new and second railway station at *Naraj* near CDA has become operational, but it is yet to be developed. No trains have their halt at that station. Ten years ago, Cuttack railway station was accorded the National Railways status but not even a single brick has been added there since then. Therefore, through you Chairman Sir, I would like to request the Railway Ministry to modernize Cuttack railway station and redevelop the railway station at *Naraj*. All the major trains may be run via this station. Provision may also be made to route all the major trains via Cuttack. Sir, Cuttack is not just a district; rather it is the judicial, medical, educational and commercial centre of the State.

Our Honorable Chief Minister has sanctioned 100 crores rupees in the State budget for the construction of an Inter-state Bus Terminal in the memory of Netaji, which will be completed within one and half year's time. Railways should take note of my concern. Thank You."
