- (a) whether there is a provision to provide any type of training to help the people in establishing business, marketing and sales as part of setting up a new business after obtaining technical training under Pradhan Mantri Kaushal Vikas Yojana (PMKVY);

- (c) if not, whether any such provision is under consideration in the near future?

# STATEMENT REFERRED TO IN REPLY TO PARTS (A) TO (C) OF RAJYA SABHA STARRED QUESTION NO. 50 TO BE ANSWERED ON 05.02.2021 ASKED BY SHRI BRIJLAL REGARDING TRAINING TO PEOPLE WHO INTEND TO SET UP BUSINESS

(a) to (c) Under Pradhan Mantri Kaushal Vikas Yojana (PMKVY) (2016-20), training is being imparted through Short Term Training (STT) courses and Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL) in around 1800 National Skills Qualifications Framework (NSQF) aligned job roles including marketing & sales across 37 sectors in the country. In order to inculcate entrepreneurship skills in the candidates for establishing business, scheme has mandatory provision for training under 155 hours English, Employability & Entrepreneurship (EEE) module apart from core curriculum of the course. Further, Training Providers provide support to the candidates for entrepreneurship development through facilitating bank linkages along with providing guidance and mentoring support. As on 19.01.2021, around 2.77 lakh candidates have been self-employed across the country.

Based on the learning from implementation of PMKVY 1.0 (2015-16) and 2.0 (2016-20), Ministry has launched PMKVY 3.0 on 15.01.2021 with demand driven and bottom up approach. Under the scheme, informed choice / aspirations of the candidates have been given primacy which aims to support the self-employment as well. This scheme also supports the vision of Atmanirbhar Bharat by promoting candidates to opt for local skills with local jobs.

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
