EXPORTS AND LOSSES IN DAIRY INDUSTRY

Will the Minister of Fisheries, Animal Husbandry and Dairying be pleased to state:

- (a) the figures for import of dairy products from India by other countries in the year 2019-20 and 2020-21; and
- (b) the details of losses, if any, faced by the dairy industry and whether the Ministry has devised any plan to help recover from the same, the details of such plans?

- (a) The figures for import of dairy products from India by other countries in the year 2019-20 and 2020-21 are as under:

- (b) There is a decline of about 3.2% in the amount of exports (rupees) during April-October 2020-21 in comparison to same period in 2019-20 which is attributed to the COVID-19. The details of plans implemented by Agricultural & Processed Food Products Export Development Authority (APEDA) to help recover from the losses by the dairy industry are as under:

- i. Export Infrastructure Development-for the development of infrastructure
- ii. Quality development- for the development of quality
- iii. Market Development- for the development of international markets

Besides, this Department is implementing following schemes which also supplement to help recover for losses, if any:-

- i. Dairy Processing and Infrastructure Development Fund (DIDF)
- ii. National Programme for Dairy Development (NPDD)
- iii. Support to Dairy Cooperatives and Farmer Producer Organisation (SDCFPO)
