- (c) the details of the mandatory and optional criteria list which would be collected as a part of Census 2021 especially by the mobile application;
- (d) whether Government has demanded any technical support for the Census 2021 from any international agency; and

(a) & (b): Mobile App for collection of data and a Census portal for management and monitoring of various Census related activities have been developed. Instruction manuals for enumerators and other Census functionaries have been prepared. A pre-test of Census was undertaken from 12th August, 2019 to 30th September, 2019 in selected areas of all the
