- (a) whether it is a fact that Railways have taken up construction of a new line from Cumbum-Prodattur in Andhra Pradesh;
- (b) when was the MoU entered into between Railways and Andhra Pradesh;
- (c) the status of construction of the new line and by when it is likely to be completed; and
- (d) the construction cost of the State and the Railways?

- (a) No Sir. Cumbum Prodattur (142.28 km) new line project was included in Budget 2013-14 subject to requisite approvals. Government of Andhra Pradesh was requested to provide land free of cost and to share 50% cost of construction for which no response was received. Therefore, the project could not be taken forward.
- (b) No MOU was entered into between Ministry of Railways and Government of Andhra Pradesh.
- (c) and (d) Do not arise as the project is not sanctioned.
