OPERATIONALISATION OF DOMESTIC AIR SERVICES TO PRE-COVID LEVEL

- (a) whether the domestic air traffic in the country has almost been normalised?
- (b) if so, the month-wise details of passenger traffic data, after November 2020 in relation to pre-COVID level?
- (c) whether Government has any plan to lift the cap imposed by Government on the operation of flights? and (d)if so, the details thereof?

ANSWER

(a) to (d) A statement is laid on the table of the house.

(a) & (b) No, Sir. The month wise details of passenger data on domestic sector, after November 2020 vis-a-vis pre COVID are as under:

Month No. of Passengers Month No. of Passenger

November 2020 63.54 lakhs December 2020 73.27 lakhs

November 2019 129.47 lakhs December 2019 130.18 lakhs

(c) & (d) Due to the outbreak of COVID 19, scheduled domestic operations were suspended w.e.f. 25.03.2020 which were subsequently resumed in a calibrated manner w.e.f. 25.05.2020. The domestic scheduled operations at present have been opened upto 80% of the Summer Schedule 2020. Further, opening up of the domestic scheduled operations is subject to prevailing COVID-19 situation, status of operations and passenger demand for air travel.
