CONTRACT AWARDED UNDER DELHI-MEERUT RRTS PROJECT

NO. 238. SHRI SUSHIL KUMAR GUPTA:

Will the Minister of HOUSING AND URBAN AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether it is a fact that the National Capital Region Transport Corporation (NCRTC) has awarded a contract to a Chinese company, Shanghai Tunnel Engineering Company Limited, for the construction of a 5.6-km underground stretch, from New Ashok Nagar to Sahibabad, of the Delhi-Meerut RRTS project;
- (b) if so, the details thereof; and
- (c) the number of companies who have submitted technical bids and how many of them qualified in the technical bid evaluation?

(a) & (b): Yes, Sir. National Capital Region Transport Corporation (NCRTC) has informed that they have awarded contract to Shanghai Tunnel Engineering Company Limited for Design and Construction of Tunnels by Tunnel Boring Machine (TBM) for a 5.6 km underground stretch, from New Ashok Nagar to Sahibabad, and one RRTS Station at AnandVihar of the Delhi-Ghaziabad-Meerut RRTS project. The funding agency for the aforesaid contract is Asian Development Bank. The tender has been finalized as per procurement guidelines of Asian Development Bank.

(c): Five companies have submitted bids and all of them were qualified in technical bid evaluation.
