INFRASTRUCTURE PROJECTS

1350. Shri M. Shanmugam:

Will the Minister of **Commerce and Industry** be pleased to state:

- (a) whether Government recently cleared ₹ 12,000 crore infrastructure projects;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) how many millions of jobs it is likely to create and in what time;
- (d) whether Industrial Corridor nodes in Andhra Pradesh and Karnataka along the ChennaiBengaluru Industrial Corridor would also get the funding; and
- (e) if so, the details thereof and by what time the Chennai-Bengaluru Industrial Corridor would be ready?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF COMMERCE & INDUSTRY (SHRI SOM PARKASH)

- (a)to(c): Government of India has approved the development of Industrial Corridor nodes at Krishnapatnam & Tumakuru (Chennai-Bengaluru Industrial Corridor) and Multi Modal Logistics Hub & Multi Modal Transport Hub (MMTH) at Greater Noida (Delhi-Mumbai Industrial Corridor) at an estimated cost of Rs. 7,725 crores and the likely employment generation will be about 2.8 lakh persons.
- (d)&(e): On 30th December, 2020, Government has approved the development of Krishnapatnam node in Andhra Pradesh (Project cost Rs. 2,139.44 crore) and Tumakuru node in Karnataka (Project cost Rs. 1,701.81 crore). The timelines for the construction of trunk infrastructure in these two nodes is 36-48 months.
