Brain drain in IITs

- †1540. SHIRIMATI MAYA SINGH: Will the Minister of HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:
- (a) whether Government are aware of the fact that talented students educated from the renowned IITs are generally selected by foreign multinational companies in the campus itself and taken abroad;
- (b) the plan to make up the loss caused to the nation with this kind of brain drain; and
 - (c) the manner in which the financial loss due to it would be made up?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT (SHRI MD. ALI ASHRAF FATMI): (a) to (c) No record of the number of engineers and technocrats, including IIT engineers, leaving the country is maintained centrally. Indian engineers, scientists and technocrats do go abroad for higher studies or employment. In the present scenario of globalization and liberalization, the movement of technical personnel across the national boundaries is not only inevitable but in many cases could give positive benefits to the country. It is considered neither feasible nor desirable to put in place a regulatory framework to prevent the movement abroad of qualified engineers and technocrats.

Central university in every State
