Expansion of forest cover

673. DR. KIRODI LAL MEENA:

Will the Minister of ENVIRONMENT, FOREST AND CLIMATE CHANGE be pleased to state:

- (a) whether Government has any plan in respect of environment conservation and expansion of forest cover;
- (b) if so, the details of expanded forest cover by means of afforestation;
- (c) the details of funds provided for conservation and afforestation during the last threeyears, year-wise and State-wise; and
- (d) the details of the funds allocated and amount utilised in this regard?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF ENVIRONMENT, FOREST AND CLIMATE CHANGE (SHRI BABUL SUPRIYO)

(a) Various schemes are being implemented by Central and State Government for improvement of forest cover in the country. These include National Afforestation Programme (NAP)and Green India Mission (GIM) being implemented by the Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change. Afforestation activities are also taken up under various programmes/funding sources such as Mahatma Gandhi National Rural Employment Guarantee Scheme, PradhanMantriKrishiSinchayeeYojana, Compensatory Afforestation Funds under Compensatory Afforestation Fund Management and Planning Authority (CAMPA). Afforestation activities are also taken up under various schemes of State Government /UT Administration.

Besides the Ministry of Agriculture and Farmers Welfare is also implementing National Agroforestry Policy since 2014. One of the goal of the National Agroforestry Policy 2014 is meeting the ever increasing demand of timber, food, fuel, fodder, fertilizer, fibre and other agroforestry products, conserving the natural resources and forest; protecting the environment & providing environmental security; and increasing the forest/tree cover. Also, Mission for Integrated Development of Horticulture (MIDH) is a Centrally Sponsored Scheme for the holistic growth of the horticulture sector covering fruits, vegetables, root & tuber crops, mushrooms, spices, flowers, aromatic plants, coconut, cashew, cocoa and bamboo.

(b) The multi-departmental efforts have yielded good results in conserving environment by addressing the problem of deforestation. Government's efforts to plant more trees have also been reflected in the assessments in biennial India State of Forest Reports (ISFR).

The forest and tree cover as reported in the latest ISFR-2019 has increased by 13,209 square kilometre as compared to that of ISFR 2015 assessment.

(c) & (d) The State/UT-wise details of fund released under National Afforestation Programme Green India Mission and Compensatory Afforestation Funds for the last three years are given in Annexure-I, II and III.
