PROVIDING TAP CONNECTION UNDER JJM

734. SHRI PARIMALNATHWANI:

Will the Minister of JAL SHAKTI be pleased to state:

- (a) the total number of houses that have been provided tap connections under the Jal Jeevan Mission (JJM) during the last two years;
- (b) the number of houses that have been provided tap connections in the State of Andhra Pradesh during the said period; and
- (c) the break-up of the tap connections provided during the last two years and the funds allocated and utilized for the same, State-wise?

ANSWER

- (a) Since announcement of Jal Jeevan Mission on 15th August, 2019, so far 3.36 Crore rural households have been provided tap water connection.
- (b) In the same period, in Andhra Pradesh, 6.26 lakh rural households have been provided tap water connection.
- (c) State/ UT-wise number of rural households provided tap water connections since announcement of Jal Jeevan Mission, is at Annex-I. Funds allocated, released and utilised by States/ UTs under JJM in 2019-20 is at Annex-II and in 2020-21 is at Annex-III.
