PIPED WATER CONNECTION IN RURAL AREAS

735. SHRI M. SHANMUGAM:

Will the Minister of JAL SHAKTI be pleased to state:

- whether Government has the data of the rural household in the country who do not have the piped water connection and if so, the details thereof, State-wise including Tamil Nadu;
- the funds sanctioned, allocated and utilized for piped water connection in the country;
- the details of the target set and achievements made so far; and
- whether Government has constituted village and water sanitation committees for this purpose and if so, the details thereof including Tamil Nadu?

- State/ UT-wise number of rural households that are yet to be provided with tap water connection, including those of Tamil Nadu is **annexed**.
- Details of Central funds allocated, released and reported to have been utilised by the States/ UTs as on 04.02.2021 under Jal Jeevan Mission (JJM) is as under:

- Government of India is implementing Jal Jeevan Mission in partnership with States, to provide tap water supply to every rural household by 2024. At the time of announcement of Jal Jeevan Mission in August, 2019, about 3.23 Crore (17%) rural households were reported to have tap water connections. Since announcement of Jal Jeevan Mission till date, 3.36 Crore rural households have been provided tap water connection. Thus, as on date, out of 19.18 Crore rural households across the country, 6.59 Crore households (34.36%) are reported to have potable tap water supply.

Further, all rural households in Goa and Telangana are reported to have tap water supply. Further, all households in 52 districts and about 74 thousand villages are reported to have tap water supply. State/ UT-wise achievements made under JJM is in public domain and available on the JJM dashboard @ <https://ejalshakti.gov.in/jjmreport/JJMIndia.aspx>.

- As reported by the State Government of Tamil Nadu, out of 12,525 villages, 7,342 VWSCs have been constituted so far.
